Itinerary 1

From the Serra d'Ivrea to the vineyards of Carema: Roppolo Castle, « La Steiva » Ethnographic Museum in Piverone, the Roman Church of Saints Peter and Paul, the Medieval Garden of St. Stephen Church in Chiaverano, the "Ring of 5 lakes", the Castle and Cathedral of Ivrea, the Montalto Dora Castle, the « Balmetti », natural cellars laid out in the moraine rock in Borgofranco d'Ivrea, Parish of St. Lawrence in Settimo Vittone, Carema.

Itinerary 2

In the lands of the Erbaluce di Caluso : the « Painted Village» to Torre Canavese, the Ducal Castle of Agliè, the Sanctuary of the Afflicted Madonna of Cuceglio, the « Nossi Rais » Ethnographic Museum of Candia Canavese, di Caluso, the Mazzè Castle, Lake Candia, the Parish Church of Saints Michael and Solutore in Strambino, the Masino Castle and the Azeglio Castle.

Itinerary 3

Along the traces of King Arduino : the Antonelliana Rotunda of Castellamonte, Arduino Street in Cuornè, the Territorial Museum and the original Sandretto Museum of Plastics in Pont Canavese, the Church of Saint Croix of Sparone, the Castle and Contemporary Art Centre of Rivara, the Belmonte Sanctuary in Valperga, the Malgrà Castle of Rivarolo Canavese, the Fruttuaria Abbey of San Benigno Canavese.

History - culture and events

Every year the city of Ivrea attracts visitors from all over the world, thanks to its medieval carnival, with the parade of the "Mugnaia", the queen of the carnival, and the "General" among others. The famous Battle of the Oranges is not to be missed.

Visitors take off to discover the marvelous landscapes of the Piedmont, of Canavese or of the Gressoney Valley, the magnificent castles like the Reggia de Venaria, the Castle of Agliè, the Castle of Masino or the Castle of Mazzè, the fortresses like the one in Bard and sanctuaries like those at Belmonte and Oropa, recognized as a World Heritage Site by Unesco.

Turin, with its wealth of history in sites like the Royal Palace, the Mole Antoneliana and the Egyptian Museum, captivates many tourists every year. Religious monuments, like the Church of San Lorenzo, the Evangelical and Methodist Valdese Church and the Sanctuary of Monte Stella are evidence of the region's impressive cultural heritage

Not to be missed

« L'Anello dei cinque laghi », (Ring of five lakes), enables visitors to plunge into a territory that has managed to preserve the integrity of millennia of natural majesty. For those who love history, several archaeological sites offer discoveries of Roman ruins that recall the splendor of this ancient Roman city.


